A clock with no hands holding an image of the stars as it appeared at the time and place of someone's death.

'Timeless' is an invitation to receive a custom—made art piece of what the stars above looked like at the exact time and place of someone's death. The stars are then held within a clock, in which the hands are no longer there, but the dial continues to turn.

During the course of artist
Andrew Binkley's solo show

participant in 'Timeless' is
part of a living and
continually growing
installation. Each individual
piece is added to the wall,
connecting to others, and
connecting to both the finite
and infinite vastness of
space, time, and beyond.
